- Attended a meeting with Bear Yuba Land Trust co-executives
- Attended meeting at fire chiefs' breakfast
- Met with Nevada City's Energy Committee
- E-pay to be brought online
- Attending a meeting with Tri-Counties Bank senior management
- Condemnation action with PG&E regarding Dutch Flat to Chicago Park Canal and associated forebay and afterbay is complete

- Boreham Gayle Pipeline Replacement Project is moving forward – 90% complete
- Maben Phase 3 should be complete by the end of September

- Attended Placer Ag Commission meeting on September 9th

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
Director Heck, Division I, reported on the following items:
